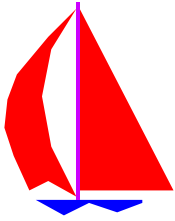
Looks like we may be getting some more space in our clubhouse.

Black on Boats.

Inboard engine mufflers can fail. Stainless steel mufflers can fail from corrosion from the inside where it is not visible to routine inspections. At the first sign of possible water leakage, your stainless steel muffler should be removed, pressure tested and repaired or replaced as appropriate. Plastic mufflers are vulnerable to a meltdown if the engine cooling water fails. At the worst such failure can flood your boat. At best it can put the engine out of commission. In a survey of 120 boats, one boat had its engine room flooded when the stainless steel muffler failed. Another boat lost its engine 600 miles off shore when the engine's raw water pump failed and the plastic muffler suffered a meltdown before the engine-overheating alarm sounded.
