## **TRIVIA**

Tidal Bore

In some areas the tide comes in in a wave. The most potent bore is in the Houghly River in India, where it comes in with the sound of Thunder. A close second is in the Petitcodiac River in New Brunswick, where the rise of the tide averages 76 feet. (Don't think I want to anchor around there!)

## **RECIPE**

Bouillabaisse

1/2 C olive oil, 2 onions chopped, 2 leeks chopped, 2 carrots chopped

1-2 cloves garlic, 2 lbs fish any mixture, 4 ripe tomatoes chopped

1 bay leaf, 1 tbsp chopped fennel, pinch saffron soaked in boiling water

pinch thyme, 2tbsp parsley, 1/4 tsp orange zest

2-3 C fish stock or water, 1 C shrimp, clams or lobster

1 tsp Lemon juice 1C white wine, French bread

Fry 1st 5 ingredients and fish chunks(boneless),Add tomatoes spices, fish stock and

cover cook 15 min. add shellfish, cook 5-8 min, add lemon juice and wine, reheat and serve with french or garlic bread.
