Racing Report:

The Major Mystery race will be held on June 12 and 13. On Saturday it will be a 10:00 start from in front of the Rod and Reel at Shelter Point. We will go around the Green Can or Mitlenatch (depends on wind direction), then through Baker Pass to finish at Major Islets. On Sunday there will be a 9:00 start in front of Lund and then down around Mystery Reef, Grants Reef and back to Pacific Playgrounds (Note - we will not attempt the Southern route if wind conditions are very light). Traditionally, a number of boats have also cruised along for the overnight trip. Some boats will stay in the Copelands and others overnight in Lund.

The America's Cup race will be held on June 26. This involves 2 races, each with 2 upwind and 2 downwind legs. Race winner will be based on the combined points for the two races. Race starts at 10:00 and 1:00 at Shelter Point.
