Gorge Harbour Weekend Race

We refer to the Gorge and Major Mystery as our cruise type races and for good reason.

This time wind and course made for a close starboard reach in less than 10 kts true wind at the start, which built to 15 – 20 kts on a broad reach approaching Marina Island. A 2 to 3 ft wind wave sea from the southeast developed in Sutil Channel. Both wind and sea eased somewhat for the last half-mile or so but not sufficiently for any skipper, considering the family group crews on board, to fly Spinnakers.

Given these conditions, it's not surprising that Windsong, designed to the Cruising Club of America handicap which promoted speed in comfort while cruising should show well against Katana, designed 20 years later to the I.O.R. handicap ratings which promoted and achieved faster speeds over the combined upwind, reaching and running legs of a typical race. The PHRF SP Handicaps bear witness to this.

Steve Gardener in “Darian” performed very respectfully particularly considering his being single handed, and experiencing at least one “spin-out” due to wind and sea strength.

The elapsed finishing times then.

Windsong 11hrs 42min 36sec

Katana 11hrs 45min 26sec

Darian 12hrs 03min 35sec

Applying PHRF handicaps did not change the rankings.
