2 GREEN ONIONS,CHOPPED

Too much Weather Helm:	1 CLOVE GARLIC, MINCED
Shift ballast towards the stern	1TSP EACH OF CUMIN AND CHILI POWDER
or Increase the size of the headsails	2 TBLSP CHOPPED FRESH CORIANDER OR PARSLEY
or Decrease the size of the Main	IN BOWL, COMBINE FIRST 5
	INGREDIENTS;MIX WELL.
Too much Lee Helm	COVER AND REFRIGERATE FOR UP TO 2 DAYS.
Shift ballast towards the bow	BEFORE SERVING, SPRINKLE WITH CORIANDER OR PARSLEY.
or Decrease the size of the headsails	(ADD CHILIES OR TOP WITH CHEDDAR CHEESE FOR EXTRA PIZAZZ)
or Increase the Main	SERVE WITH SMALL BREAD STICKS, PITA POINTS,CRACKERS, ON BUNS OR WHATEVER SUITS YOUR FANCY!
