1- NFS stands for No Flying Sails i.e. Spinnakers, Jennakers, Bloopers etc. are not allowed with the rating.
 Ratings are based on seasonal averages and as such, equipment cannot be routinely changed from race to race.

2- Prestart time for your boat compared to a faster boat is your RTG# (Seconds per mile) subtracted from competitors RTG# which gives you your advantage per mile, times the distance of the race which gives you your allotted time to start early
 Eg: Chandell vs Seabear V, over 11 miles: 220-154=66sec's/mile*11miles=726seconds
 726 seconds / 60 = a 12minute, 6 second lead
