Japanese Cabbage Salad

1 cabbage, shredded

1 bunch green onion, chopped

1 8 oz. can water chestnuts, sliced

1-tablespoon sesame seeds

1/2 cup toasted slivered almonds

1-package Japanese buckwheat noodles, crumbled

1/2-cup oil

1/4-cup soy sauce

7 3/4 grams beef flavoured bouillon, seasoning from noodles

1 dash vinegar

Mix the oil, soy sauce, beef bouillon and vinegar to make the dressing.

Mix the remaining ingredients in a bowl and add the dressing just before serving.
