*SUNSHINE GREETINGS TO MARTIN BROEREN AND DENNIS FREWER. HOPE YOU ARE FEELING BETTER.*

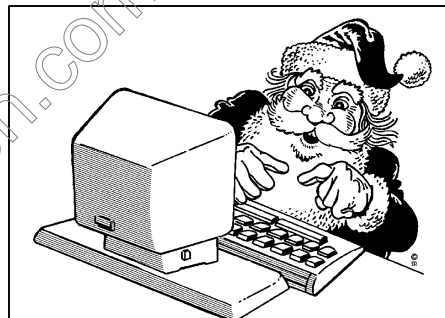
