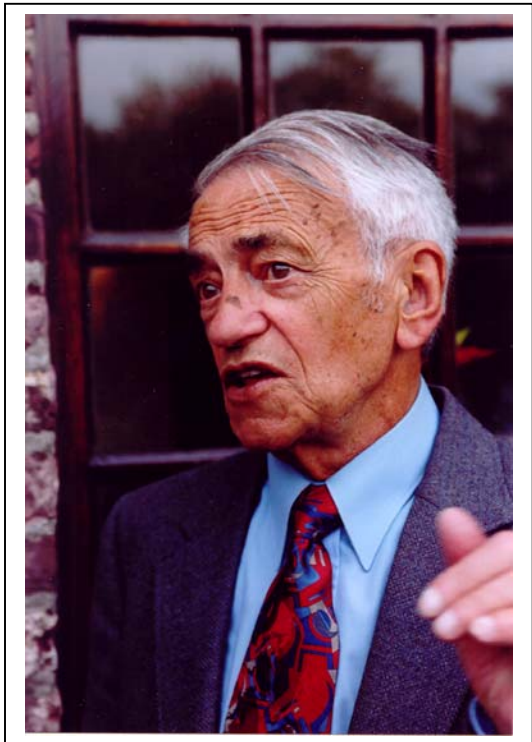

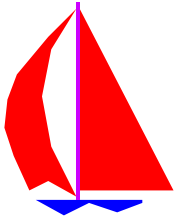

First race was the better, starting in NW 10kt winds which veered to NE and dropped to 5kts in the hour it took the fleet to complete the 3 NM course.

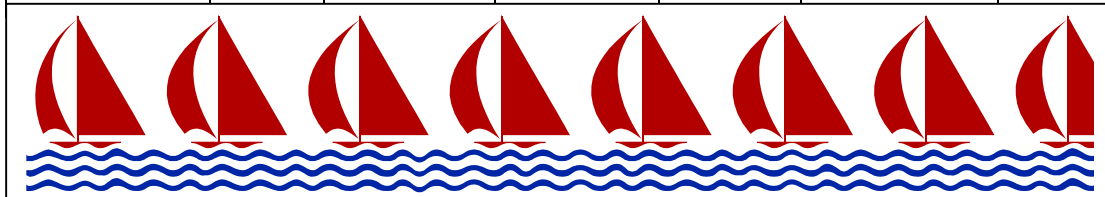
This posted the faster times, as the wind died to ghosting zephyrs during the second race. These times adjusted by PHRF time on distance handicaps are the race shown below in the results.
