
We are very pleased to invite you and your members to use our facilities when visiting the Victoria area. We are no longer a Customs clearing station except for CFSA Yachts Berthed at CFSA. This change is due to the heightened security measures in place in Canadian ports. As part of these measures, visiting yachts must call "Port Security" on Channel 10 VHF prior to entering Esquimalt harbour and report the name of the yacht, number of persons aboard and your destination (CFSA). All craft must keep clear of military facilities such as wharves and there are YELLOW buoys off the naval jetties to define the closest allowable approach. Under normal conditions this is all a matter of routine but you may be approached by a guard boat for a visual inspection. Boarding is unlikely.

Reciprocal facilities and services are as follows; first two days moorage – no charge. further moorage at \$0.50/ft/day to a total of 7 days alongside twice yearly; water and 15 amp. Electricity is available on the floats at no charge; shower and hot water – no charge;

As you round the caissons the customs dock at the end of "B" float will be visible. Both ends of the main float to the east and at right angles to "B" float is our visitors berth and may be approached from both ends of the caissons. After you have secured your vessel please register your arrival at the bar or the office in the double trailer below the Clubhouse. If neither place is open, contact the Foreshore Chairman, Jack Dennett at 385-7833.

Please fly your burgee at all times during your visit with us. Enjoy your stay.
