

REGISTRATION

Welcome to Pacific Playgrounds Resort and Marina. The C.R.Y.C. clubhouse is located on their property and is home to many member boats.

Moorage is on a first come first serve basis, year round, and is available to paid-up members of reciprocal clubs. The marina has made the five spaces between slips 275 and 281 on finger "J" (first to port when entering the Marina) available for reciprocal use. Those slips are suitable for boat up to 34 feet. Larger boats may be accommodated when space is available in the Marina. (Check with the Marina Office regarding this) Tie up at one of the available spaces and then register at the Marina Office showing your paid membership with a reciprocal club.

Harbour: Location is adjacent to
and just south of the
Oyster River Estuary

Latitude: 049° 52.27' N

Longitude: 125° 06.5' W

There are marked posts along the dredged channel leading to the harbour entrance. The depth is shallowest by the outermost post. When entering, keep the first post (green) to port and stay close to the line of posts to starboard. You will need a tide height (ref: Mittlenatch or Campbell River Tide table Book 5) of minimum 5.0 ft for a boat with a draft of 4.5 ft through the channel.

CAUTION: this channel is quite narrow and exposed to SE winds. Do NOT attempt passage during high swells or winds.

PROVISIONING

Minor supplies are available at the harbour office/store. Otherwise Discovery Foods Supermarket and a liquor store is a 10-minute walk.

Follow Balsam and Cottage Lane from the harbour heading west along the cottages bordering the Oyster River. Past the last cottage, follow the short trail on your right leading to the bridge and cross it. On your right is the Fisherman's Pub, adjacent to the Oyster River Park. Take the first turn to the left (Glenmore

Road) and you will find Discovery Foods a ½ block on your left.

FUEL

Gas and diesel available in the Marina but no propane.

TRANSPORTATION

The bus stop for Campbell River Transit is on Glenmore Road, directly across from Discovery Foods.

C.R. Transit takes 28 minutes to downtown Campbell River. The double zone fare is currently \$2.50. Correct change is required.

RECREATION

Pacific Playgrounds offers camping, a swimming pool, tennis courts, and adjacent to it is a 9-hole golf course with a putting green and driving range.

HIKING/FISHING:

Oyster River Park has a good trail system extending to Salmon Point Pub at Kuhushan Point. The river and foreshore support mainly Cutthroat Trout and Salmon. Please check the fishing regulations. There is frequently good salmon fishing a short distance from the Marina.

PUMPOUT

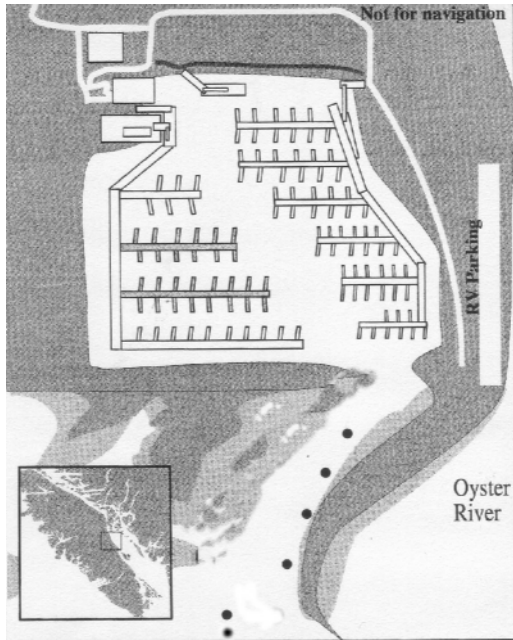
Available at the Fisherman's Wharf (formerly the Government Dock) in Campbell River.

CLUBHOUSE

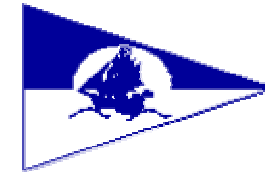
The clubhouse is not staffed and is normally only open for meeting and member social events.
