



Sidney North Saanich Yacht Club Moorage Information for Reciprocal Visitors Spring/Summer 2009

WELCOME

We look forward to your visit to Sidney North Saanich Yacht Club — we hope you enjoy your stay! With our big 260' dock and rafting required to two boats deep, we almost always have room to fit in another boat. Please visit our website at www.snsyc.ca

MOORAGE

We are located at 48° 40.4 North, 123° 24.3 West, at the western side of Tsehum Harbour, north of Sidney, British Columbia. Moorage is on a First come First served basis. You must be a paid-up member of a reciprocal yacht club.

- Two nights free moorage every four weeks.
- Free nights may be two consecutive nights, or two visits of one night each.
- Additional paid nights can be arranged.

If arriving directly from the U.S., stop at the west end of Van Isle Marina gas dock, and phone 888-226-7277 for Customs/Immigration clearance.

CLUBHOUSE FACILITIES

- Club bar open: • Wednesday to Friday from 4 pm
 - Saturdays, Sundays, & Canadian Holiday Mondays from 1 pm.
- Gourmet dinner from our chef Kevan MacKay Wednesday to Sunday from 5:30 pm
 - reservations recommended at the bar or phone 250-656-4600.
- Free internet access in our clubhouse on our desktop computer, or your computer using our wireless connection. BroadbandXpress at our dock.
- 24-hour Washrooms & Showers

REGISTRATION

A friendly dock host may come by to greet you and register you at the dock, otherwise register at the clubhouse bar during clubhouse hours, showing your current yacht club membership card. Pay any required fees to the club staff. Display the registration slip on your boat.

If you leave your boat unattended before the club opens or a dock host comes by, fill in a registration envelope from the blue cupboard on the dock shed, to display on your boat.

2009 RECIPROCAL DOCK CLOSURES

The entire dock is closed to reciprocal visitors:

- For our Sailpast, May 2, 2009.
- For Racing events March 27 to 29, September 11 to 13, and September 18 to 20, 2009, except to participating racers.

The east side and south end of the dock is closed:

- Sundays, 11:00 am to 3:00 pm for Junior Sailing April 5 to May 31, and September 13 to October 4.
- Thursday evenings, 4:00 to 8:00 pm for Junior Sailing June 11 to September 3.
- Monday to Friday, 9:00 am to 4:00 pm July 6 to August 28 for our Sailing School.
- The west side of the dock is open to reciprocal visitors during these sessions.

FEES (Canadian Currency)

First two night's moorage: Free (except for electricity.) Additional nights: 50¢/foot

Electricity (15 amps): \$3.00/night Showers: \$1 coin for 5 minutes.

Gate key & washroom code: From the Club Bar or a Dock Host. There is a \$25 charge for missing keys.

WHILE AT THE DOCK

- **DISPLAY YOUR REGISTRATION FORM IN A DOCKSIDE WINDOW ON YOUR VESSEL.**
- **FLY YOUR CLUB BURGEE.**
- Rafting two boats deep is mandatory.
- And all the usual things, like... Use a holding tank, or on-shore facilities. Keep your dog on a leash while on the dock. Operate engines, generators, etc. during daylight hours only, quietly please. No open flames, welding, braising. Etc...

LEAVING

Before leaving, pay any required fees at the clubhouse bar. If the clubhouse is closed, deposit cash or cheque in a Registration Envelope into the slot in the lock box.

If you haven't registered at the club or with a dock host, fill in and deposit an envelope, even if you don't owe any fees. We like to know who has visited us.

Drop the SNSYC gate key into the lock box on the dock shed.
